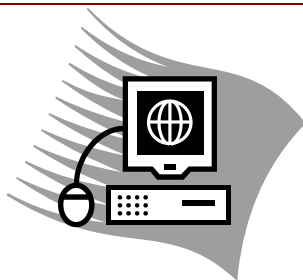


## *Financial Aid Cent\$*

### Information You Need to Know



For many of our students, January 5<sup>th</sup> is the disbursement date for their Spring term aid. This includes students in the School of Public Health and the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences, as well as TCOM's Physician's Assistant classes of 2009, 2010, 2011 and DO classes 2012 and 2011. Now is a great time to consider setting up direct deposit for your Financial Aid refunds checks. The process takes about 10 business days, so submitting the paperwork before December 1<sup>st</sup> should allow you to receive your January refund electronically. The form is on the web and is completely interactive - fill in your information, click submit, and you're done! Simply complete the direct deposit form, then all subsequent refunds are electronic.
