

Dr. Doug Mains is Associate Director in the Office of Strategy and Measurement and Associate Professor in Health Management and Policy in the School of Public Health.

Dr. Mains earned a BA in Humanities from University of Texas at Austin (1981), MBA from The McCombs School of Business (1984), MPAff from the LBJ School of Public Affairs (1984) and DrPH from University of Texas – Houston School of Public Health (1990).

Dr. Mains is the SACS accreditation liaison for UNTHSC and has served as an examiner for the Quality Texas Foundation since 2006. He is a Public Health Leadership Institute fellow from 2001 and is a member of the National Public Health Leadership Development Network, where he served as chair of the Evaluation Working Group and member of the Executive Committee from 2004-2010.
