The School of Nursing offers a prelicensure BSN program (enrollment of 800), an online RN-BSN program (enrollment of 200), Master's degree programs in Nursing Education, Nursing Administration, and Nurse Practitioner programs in nine specialty areas (enrollment of 400), a Doctorate in Nursing Practice program (beginning Fall 2009), and a PhD in Nursing program (enrollment of 39). Half of the 110 faculty hold an earned doctorate and a third are engaged in research. The Genomics Translation Research Lab and the Smart Hospital serve as both learning laboratories and research and development centers.
